WHEN: Sunday, April 29, 2018 from 1:00pm - 5:00pm

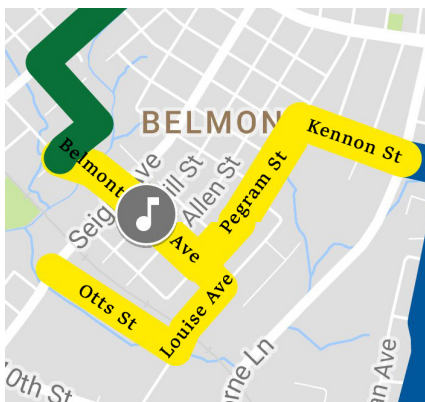
WHERE: Belmont Ave, Pegram St, Kennon St, Louise Ave, and Otts St
